



## Duston Sports and Leisure Complex

Duston Sport and Leisure Complex (DSLCL) Working Party is looking to recruit two volunteers from the Duston community to supplement and diversify its membership. The Working Party is required to be made up of representatives of several User Groups, up to three representatives of Duston Parish Council and two representatives of the Duston Community.

The objectives of the Working Party are to redevelop the former Timken sports and leisure facilities for the benefit of Duston residents and the Community at large. It is envisaged that the Charity will be managed by a Board of Directors formed largely from the DSLCL working party.
